Oliver Jörg, father of three children, was born in 1972 in Aalen and studied law at the universities of Passau, Würzburg and Linz (Austria). He was admitted to the German Bar in 2004 and practiced as a lawyer full time for four years. Before being appointed as the Secretary General of the Hanns Seidel

Foundation in 2019, he spent 10 years as a Member of the

Bavarian State Parliament. During this time, one of his responsibilities was to be chairperson of the Parliamentary Committee for Higher Education, Research and Culture. In addition, he chaired the working group Active Civil Society / Voluntary Work of the CSU Parliamentary group. Mr. Jörg had a lasting influence on the Bavarian scientific landscape, particularly in decentralizing higher education and strengthening the cooperation between universities of applied sciences and the private sector. While in Parliament he was particularly focused on the social development of Bavaria regarding its civil society, culture and the preservation of monuments.
